ML Tenacity was built by Tyler Boats in 1976 for the Thames Police and served on the River Thames until the late 90s. She found her way to the Isle of Wight and until 2019 operated there as a yard work boat.

ML Tenacity was purchased by Severne Snow Limited in June 2019 and extensively re-built in Littlehampton with advice and guidance from TT Boat Design to meet the Maritime Coastguard Agency Work Boat Code Second Edition. The re-build included extensive hull stiffening and the installation of a flush deck aft of the wheelhouse.
